

Dear Leader

Thank you for your booking for our Fundays event, we hope the following information proves useful.

Arrival

The event opens at 10am on the Saturday and 9:30am on the Sunday, however car-parking teams will be on duty between 8:30am and 11am.

Registration and Reception

To assist with the smooth running, we ask that only a single representative books your group in. Please ensure that this person has your booking reference number (shown on your booking confirmation), completed nominal roll form and either cash or a cheque to pay for additional people. (Cheques should be made payable to 'The Scout Association'). Please remember you are only allowed up to 3 additional people on the day. Refunds cannot be given for lower numbers of attendees as activities have been arranged for the numbers booked. You will be issued with a pack/envelope which will include programmes, badges, wristbands and/or ID cards, tickets for t-shirts / packed lunches (if applicable) and emergency procedures –please familiarise yourself with these.

Activities

Activities will start at 10am on the Saturday and finish at 4:30pm and on the Sunday; activities will start at 9:30am and finish at 4:00pm. There will be a designated lunch break between 12:30pm and 1:15pm on both days. Swimming and rafting may be included among the activities available, so please ensure your group brings swimming costumes and a towel. Some of the other activities will also involve water so a change of clothes is also recommended. Water activities tend to be more popular during the afternoon, so you may wish to consider advising your young people to attend these throughout the day. Some activities will be for Beavers only, whilst others will be for Cubs only, these will be marked on the maps and at the activity bases themselves. Activities are intended specifically for the Cub and Beaver age ranges. In order to give the maximum opportunity to the young people, helpers and leaders are permitted to take part in limited activities, please see website for details. www.fundays.org.uk

Additional Information

First aid and lost and found facilities will be available throughout the day. Their location is marked on all maps, and will be clearly signposted from the Camp Square. Uniform is not required, however a neckerchief and/or group t-shirt should be worn if possible, as this helps to reunite lost Cubs and Beavers with their groups. It would also be helpful to us if your Cubs and Beavers know their group name or carry their group name on them so that we can find their leaders as quickly as possible. Lunch is not provided as part of the fee, so please inform your group to bring a packed lunch. Light refreshments will be available for leaders and helpers in the Lid.

Please take the time to talk to us during the day and let us know your opinions on any aspect of the event. The Gilwell Park Staff and Volunteer Service Team want you to have the best day you possibly can, so if you encounter anything that requires our attention, please let us know immediately so that we can sort it out for you there and then.
